TRAVEL INFORMATION

Air Canada offers a direct flight between Toronto and Zurich on a daily basis.

To be in Zurich for Saturday, February 1, you must depart Toronto on Friday, January 31, at 17:00 on Flight 878.

Bookings must be made at www.aircanada.com and enter the promotional code in the search field.

The discount varies based on the ticket booked, there is no discount offered on an economy basic ticket and Aeroplan points will be awarded based on the fare booked.

If you wish to travel back to Canada with the group, book Air Canada Flight 879 departing Zurich on Saturday, February 8, at 09:25. You will arrive in Toronto at 12:15 on the same day.

Airport transfers between the Zurich airport and Anthony's Hotel will be arranged based on the flights noted above. If you choose not to fly on the above flights but wish to be included in the airport transfer, please indicate this request when you complete your online registration.

- Early-bird deadline is October 31, 2019.
- Secure your space with a \$500 deposit by October 31, 2019.
- A deposit of 50% of the total registration cost is to be paid by December 15, 2019. The balance of the fees will be charged on January 15, 2020.
- Any cancellations between November 1 and December 15, 2019, will incur a charge of \$250 per person.
- Any cancellations between December 16, 2019, and January 15, 2020, will incur a charge of \$500 per person.
- No refunds will be issued for cancellations after January 15, 2020.

FAQ

Do I need a Visa to travel to Switzerland, Austria or Germany?

No. Canadian citizens using Canadian passports do not require a visa to enter any of these countries for tourism or business stays under ninety (90) days.

What is the currency in Austria?

The national currency in Austria is the Euro.

Tourists can exchange Canadian dollars into Euros in Austria, however, it would probably be cheaper to buy Euros before leaving home. There are ATM machines within the village and they dispense Euros. The more common credit cards used are Visa and MasterCard, but American Express and Diners are also accepted.

Do I need adapters and/or converters in Austria?

Yes. The voltage in Austria, as in most of Europe, is 230V/50 Hz. This is twice the standard household voltage in North America. Furthermore, Austria uses type C (2 round pins) and Type F (2 round pins and 2 earth clips on the side) plugs. As such, it is recommended to bring an adaptor and a converter.

What kind of temperatures can I expect?

The average minimum and maximum temperatures at the beginning of February in St. Anton are -7°C and 2°C.

Which languages are spoken in St. Anton?

All staff at Anthony's Hotel speak English. Staff in most tourist areas in the village (such as restaurants, shops and ski hills) also speak English. While English is often heard, the most common language spoken in St. Anton is German.

Will I receive a certificate of attendance for this meeting?

Yes, certificates will be sent out electronically following the meeting. The total amount of Continuing Education credits is yet to be determined.
